Introducing our Consecration Sunday speaker...

Bishop Thomas B. Stockton serves as Bishop in Residence at High Point University. In this capacity he works with students, parents, administrators, and faculty as the institution seeks to better serve students and honor its responsibilities as a private, church - related university. He also preaches for Chapel worship services several times each semester.



Bishop Stockton's formal education includes degrees from Davidson College, Duke University Divinity School, and study at Cambridge University. Pfeiffer University and Shenandoah University have awarded him honorary Doctor of Divinity degrees. Dr. Stockton served as Bishop of The Virginia Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church, 1988-1996. He serves as a Trustee of High Point University, and his experience includes service with distinction to six churches in the Western North Carolina Conference, the last of which were Wesley Memorial in High Point and Myers Park in Charlotte.

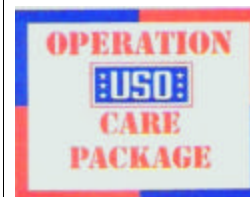

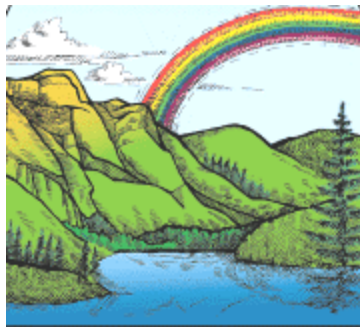

The place to learn about the love of God.

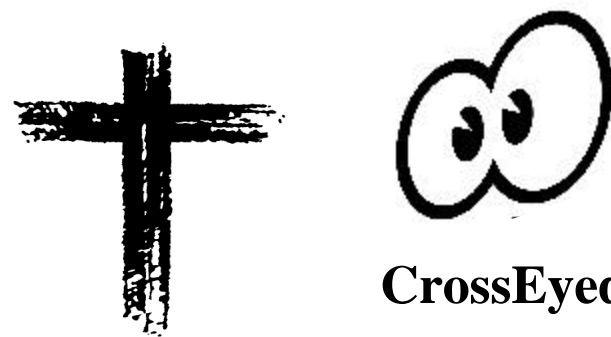
