"Do not Worry!" Easier said than done sometimes, isn't it. Several years ago I found out, at the last moment, that I would be needed to lead a Building Team to Armenia. The scheduled team leader's son had died in an automobile accident and would be unable to go. I must admit I was very worried. Elizabeth had already decided to go on this team as part of her Senior Project at Central Davidson High School. Now, two of us would be going. How could we afford to go? Would everything be O.K.? Would Elizabeth be safe?

Then I heard a voice late one night say, "Trust Me and Me alone. Everything will be alright!" I was reminded that night of when Peter got out of the boat and walked on water. It had been a long hard day, and Jesus sent the disciples on across the lake. He then went up on the mountain to be alone while he prayed to God. Late that night after praying for a long time, Jesus walked across the water to meet his disciples. When they saw Him they were afraid, terrified. ²⁷But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." ²⁸"Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." ²⁹"Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. ³⁰But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" ³¹Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" (Matthew 14:22-36)

I found myself, much like Peter. Jesus was calling me to trust him, to do what friends do for other friends; to get out of the boat and walk on the water. That year, twenty-one team members went and fixed two homes in Berdazor. This was the most team members we have ever had go at one time.

I must admit that since that night, I have had several occasions where I have been like Peter and began to look at how strong the wind was, how big the waves were. I have panicked and not trusted Christ fully. But many times, in the end, it has all worked out. God has shown me so much love, abundance, and grace.

I pray that I can get out of the boat more often and trust Jesus. I pray that I will step across the water and NOT worry about the waves and the wind, focusing only on Christ and the mission and ministry he needs me to accomplish. May we, as Archdale United Methodist Church, step out onto the waters when Christ calls us out, trusting him, and him alone.
