J. ALEXANDER (AL) WARD, JR.

J. Alexander Ward, Jr., he prefers to be called "Al," was born and raised in Durham, North Carolina. Al graduated from Northern High School (1970), High Point University (BA, 1974), The Divinity School of Duke University (MDiv, 1977), and Columbia Theological Seminary (DMin, 1998). He has also completed clinical pastoral education at Carolinas Medical Center in Charlotte, NC (1990-91) and the Royce and Jane Reynolds Program in Church Leadership through Duke University Divinity School (2004).

Al is an ordained Elder (retired) in the Western North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church. He is the third generation on his father's side to be in ordained ministry in the Western North Carolina Conference.

Al served pastoral appointments across North Carolina in Kernersville, Bahama, Cramerton, Black Mountain, Gastonia, Charlotte, Asheville, and High Point; and was the District Superintendent of the Waynesville District. He retired from pastoral ministry in 2017 and is currently Clergy in Residence at High Point University (High Point, NC).

Al is a member of the Board of Trustees of High Point University (High Point, NC) and he is the Chair of the Board of Directors of Hinton Rural Life Center (Hayesville, NC).

He has been married to Miriam (HPU, 1973) for 46 years. They have two daughters, Erin Ward of Los Angeles, CA; and Meredith Vaughn of Kernersville, NC. They have four granddaughters, Kirthi Rao of Los Angeles, CA; Savannah Vaughn, Vivian Vaughn and Braelyn Vaughn of Kernersville, NC. He enjoys running and reading biographies, mysteries, and historical fiction.
